## EARLY DISMISSAL INFORMATION-

Students who do not have an ACT subscore of 17 in English AND an ACT subscore of 19 in Math (or SAT equivalency or the Silver level on the ACT WorkKeys for the CTE endorsement) *must meet ALL 4 of the following requirements in order to be eligible to have early dismissal during their Senior year:* 

- have the required 2.5 overall GPA
- have passed or met all MAAP assessments (state test) requirements for graduation
- be on track to meet diploma requirements (passing all required classes)
- be concurrently enrolled in Essentials for College Math and/or Essentials for College Literacy

## EARLY GRADUATION OPTION-

A diploma endorsement (CTE, Academic, or Distinguished) is required for all early graduates.

Exceptions to this policy may be granted due to extreme hardship situations and must have the prior approval of the District Superintendent or designee.
